STATEMENT OF BRITT JOHNSON

3 I, BRITT JOHNSON, declare as follows:

- 4 1. My name is Britt Johnson. I am a pre-law advisor at the University of California,
5 Santa Barbara. I have had this position for the past 24 years. My job entails advising
6 students regarding the entire law school application process.
- 7 2. Fifty-percent of advising students on the law school application process is spent on
8 advising students about the Law School Admission Test (LSAT) and how to prepare
9 for the LSAT.
- 10 3. When students ask me about which company they should prepare with, I tell them
11 about the three biggest players in LSAT Preparation are Kaplan, The Princeton
12 Review, and TestMasters.
- 13 4. When I advise students, I always ask those enrolled in LSAT preparation courses
14 what they think of their LSAT preparation course. I always get positive feedback
15 from students who take TestMasters. Lately, I have been advising students who are
16 looking into LSAT Preparation Courses to really look into TestMasters because
17 TestMasters has become very popular and I have heard many good things about them
18 from my students. Even though, I tell them to look into TestMasters, I also tell them
19 that they should research each of the three companies, as I believe that they should
20 make an informed decision.
- 21 5. Sometime in late April or early May 2003, I was having one of my typical
22 conversations with one of my students. When I told this student to do his own
23 research on TestMasters despite what I had told him about TestMasters, he told me
24 that the TestMasters website said that they would not be holding classes in California.

- 1 I thought that what he had said must be wrong, and I told him that this was
2 impossible. I also told him to let me do some research and get back to him.
3 6. When I did the research, I put into the address bar of the Worldwide Web,
4 www.testmasters.com, and I had the same experience as my student. I came across a
5 website called TestMasters that stated that there would be no classes in California.
6 7. Then I had remembered that I had seen a TestMasters ad banner on the U.S. News &
7 World Report website, so I went to the US News & World Report website, where I
8 found that banner. I clicked on the banner and I got to the real TestMasters website,
9 located at www.testmasters180.com.
10 8. Over the last couple of weeks, I have talked to approximately seven other students
11 who have had the experience of going to the wrong website and believing that
12 TestMasters is not offering classes in California.

14 I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct, and that this declaration
