DECLARATION OF NAGWA IBRAHIM

I, Nagwa Ibrahim, declare as follows:

2. I had taken TestMasters' LSAT preparation course in the spring of 2001 in preparation for the June LSAT exam. I really enjoyed the course. My teacher was wonderful and I learned a lot about how to take the LSAT from the course. Unfortunately, I did not get the score I really wanted when I took the actual test. I decided to put off law school for a year or two and focus on working.
3. Around June 2003 I decided that I would take October LSAT. It had been almost two years since I had studied for the LSAT so I decided to take the TestMasters course again.
4. I went to what I thought was the website for TestMasters, www.testmasters.com, to look at the summer schedule for their classes being held at UCLA. The website gave no indication on it that it was not the TestMasters' created by Robin Singh. In fact it had the same logo as the TestMasters' I had previously taken classes with.

5. I clicked on schedules and locations. It brought me to a map of the United States. When I clicked on California a message popped up, stating: "Unfortunately, we are not offering classes for the LSAT in California in 2003. We suggest consulting your yellow pages for alternate preparation options for the LSAT."
6. This really confused me because I knew that TestMasters was based out of California. I didn't understand why if they were based out of California they were not holding classes in California.
7. A few weeks later I was talking to a friend of mine who was studying for the October LSAT. He told me he was taking a TestMasters' course being held in Berkeley to prepare for the test. It was when he said this that I realized the website I had visited a few weeks back did not belong to the same TestMasters. Fortunately, my friend gave me the correct contact information and I was able to enroll in Late Summer UCLA TestMasters course in preparation for the October exam.
