2 1. My name is Susan Yoon and I am a graduate of Pomona College.


3 2. I was interested in signing up for the TestMasters LSAT preparation  
4 course in Long Beach in preparation for the October 2003 LSAT. I was referred to  
5 TestMasters by Dennis Wu, a former TestMasters student. To sign up for the  
6 course, I went to what I believed to be the TestMasters website  
7 (www.testmasters.com). On the website, there was a map of the United States  
8 where you could click the mouse on a state and then the schedule of classes being  
9 offered in that state would appear on the screen. It looked as though the company  
10 on the website was offering LSAT classes all around the country, which was  
11 consistent with what I knew to be true about the TestMasters I was looking for. But  
12 when I clicked on the image of California, a message appeared on the screen stating  
13 that TestMasters would not be holding classes in California in 2003. I then told  
14 Dennis Wu that TestMasters was not having classes in California this year, and he  
15 told me that TestMasters had closed their operations for 2003.

16 3. I then spoke with my friend, Jenny Yu, and told her that I heard that  
17 TestMasters had gone out of business. She did some research and told me that I  
18 must have gone to the wrong website for TestMasters, as they are still in business.  
19 She provided me with the correct website. If I had not spoken to Jenny Yu, I would  
20 have believed that TestMasters was closed and may have signed up for a prep class  
21 with another company.
